2. **Elizabethan Collar-** This is a lamp shade cone that goes on your pet's neck to prevent licking/chewing of the surgical site. An e-collar is highly recommended to prevent post-operative damage to the surgical site. The owner is held financially responsible for all post-operative care needed as a result of not purchasing and e-collar or other post-operative needs.

3. **Additional Anesthesia monitoring package-** (Electrocardiogram & blood pressure)
All surgical patients are monitored with a pulse oximeter, which reads their heart rate and blood oxygen levels during surgery. The additional monitoring package includes additional electrocardiogram (ECG) and blood pressure monitoring. An ECG assesses the heart function during anesthesia.

4. **If your pet has fleas it will be treated with a fast acting (24hr Effective) flea control in our hospital. Fleas are easily spread and put your pet and other pets here at risk. If the veterinarian deems it necessary to administer Capstar you will be obligated to a \$6 fee.**

5. **You understand that your pet may be kept overnight without staff present. This ensures the safety of the pet by being kept confined, and medicated by a nurse the following morning. This will be non-negotiable if the doctor deems this necessary. All spay appointments and feline dentals will stay overnight.** _____

I certify that I own the above described animal and authorize Pawsitive Vet Care to hospitalize/treat said animal. During this time they may administer vaccinations, medications, tests, surgical procedures, anesthetics, or treatments they deem necessary for the health, safety, and wellbeing of my pet while the care and supervision of the hospital. I understand there are inherent risks associated with anesthetics, medical and surgical procedures, including death. I authorize the doctors of Pawsitive Vet Care to initiate care to address complication, should they arise while under their care. In the event of an emergency, the hospital will make every reasonable attempt to contact me so that I am aware of the situation, so I am involved in medical decisions. The contact phone numbers in my chart are correct. If my pet should injure itself in an escape attempt, refuse food, soil self, become ill, or die while in the hospital, I will hold Pawsitive Vet Care and staff free of all responsibility and/ or liability in the absence of gross negligence.

I further realize that I am responsible for payment of all above mentioned procedures/ treatments in full at the time of my pets discharge. If I neglect to pick up my pet within 7 days of notice that my pet is being released Pawsitive Vet Care may assume that the animal has been abandoned. In such instances, Pawsitive Vet Care is then authorized to take care of my pet as they see fit, including euthanasia or adoption. Abandonment however, does not release me of the responsibility of my obligation for payment of said bill.
